During the 2024-2025 fiscal year, PACE celebrated 35 years of service. The anniversary was not just a milestone in our history; it was a testament to the collective effort, dedication, and unwavering commitment of everyone who has been a part of the PACE community. PACE positioned itself to become one of the leading agencies in the Bay Area and the only autism agency to provide two dedicated school campuses to serve the needs of elementary and high school/postsecondary students.

PACE enrollment continues to grow, as we added more students to our San Aleso Campus and opened our first dedicated Kindergarten classroom. In August 2024, Sunny Days Preschool opened its second classroom to serve younger children, ages 2.5 to 4 years old.

PACE also collaborated with The ARC, Alaska Airlines, and the San Jose Airport to hold its first Wings for All event. A truly wonderful opportunity for our families to experience what it is like to travel by air for the first time.

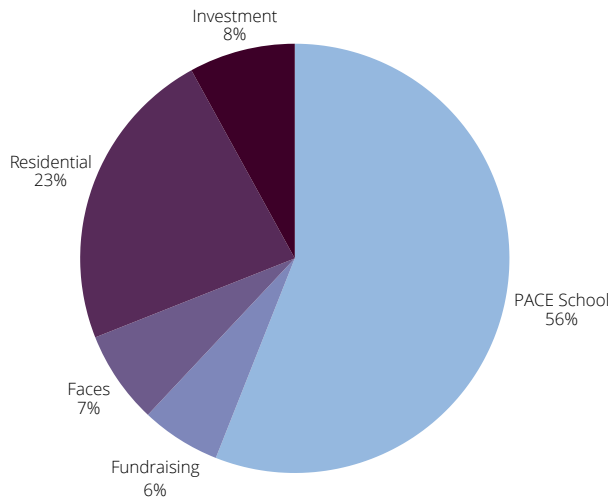

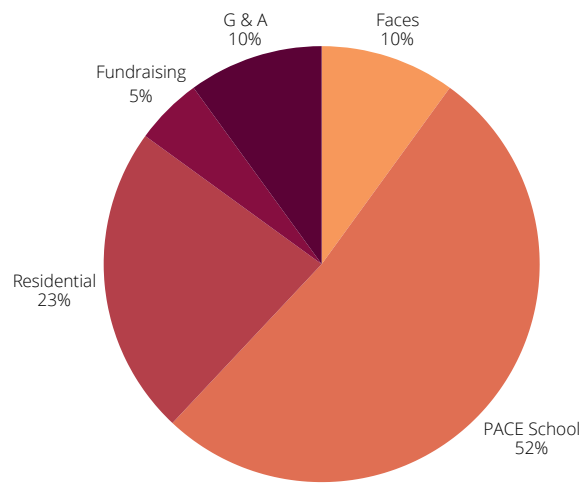
FY 2024-2025 Revenue and Expense

Agency Highlights July 2024 - June 2025



In December 2024, PACE celebrated **35** years of supporting our community. This milestone is a reflection of the incredible growth we've achieved together and the many lives impacted along the way. We are grateful to our staff, families, partners, and supporters who have been part of this journey and we look forward to continuing our mission for many years to come.

Thanks to our donors, families, PACE staff, volunteers, and community partners, our 2025 April Autism Acceptance Month fundraising events were a success. To start the month, PACE held its second PACE Art and Community Exhibition, where every student worked to create art for sale to benefit the community. PACE also partnered with the San Jose Sharks for their annual Autism Acceptance Night, which featured a special sensory room for families, and the PACE Youth Leadership Committee held an online fundraising campaign throughout the month. In total, we raised over **\$15,000** for the PACE Annual Fund.

The 2025 **Bay Area Real Estate Round Table** was held in May at the Half Moon Bay Ritz Carlton. The annual event brought over 250 attendees from the Bay Area and across the U.S. to support PACE and bring awareness of autism to the real estate world. Thanks to sponsors and donors, the event raised over **\$665,000** for PACE.

The **16th Annual PACE Golf Classic** returned at Cinnabar Hills Golf Club on September 27, 2024. With 112 golfers, the event raised over **\$139,000** for the agency, and included one of the most successful live auctions in the event's history. With proceeds from the fund-a-need portion of the event, we were able to purchase a new van for the PACE residential program.

The Sunny Days campus opened a second classroom dedicated to our youngest learners, ages 2.5 to 30 months. Our older preschool students continue their learning with extended hours, allowing for an increased focus on Pre-K readiness.

The PACE School: Wishbook Grant Enhances Vocational Program



In the fall of 2024, PACE was a recipient of the 2024 San Jose Mercury News Wish Book Grant. Of the \$20,000 awarded, \$10,000 was dedicated to expanding PACE's Vocational Program, helping provide students with many real-world learning opportunities.

PACE's Vocational Program offers hands-on experiences that build workplace readiness and independence. With the support of the Wish Book funding, students have taken on new on-campus jobs where they practice essential skills such as clocking in and out, following dress codes, and managing responsibilities. Students now wear uniforms for roles at Cicero's Pizza and volunteer vests for community service, reinforcing professional presentation and accountability. They also manage laundering and caring for their work clothing, building independence and confidence.

Our vocational skills room has been upgraded to better reflect real work environments, including restaurant, retail, and mailroom settings, while also supporting life skills such as meal preparation and laundry. A new induction stovetop has enhanced our cooking curriculum, making lessons safer and more interactive.

The Wish Book grant has also supported the purchase of job-specific tools and materials for tasks such as bike maintenance, van cleaning, and restocking supplies. Additionally, students are gaining customer service and technical skills through the expansion of our School Store, which will soon include a cash register, barcode system, and expanded inventory.

Beyond campus, new partnerships, such as with Grassroots Ecology, are creating opportunities for students to volunteer in community gardens and gain hands-on experience. Looking ahead, PACE plans to introduce monthly job site tours and mini-internships to further prepare students for future employment.

With the Wish Book Grant, PACE has been able to strengthen our vocational program, empowering students to build skills, confidence, and a sense of purpose as they prepare for life beyond the classroom.



Wings for All

In March 2025, PACE partnered with The Arc, Alaska Airlines, San Jose Airport, and TSA for the first time to give more than 40 families of children with special needs the chance to experience air travel without ever leaving the ground. Individuals from all of our programs were welcome to take part in the day.

Families practiced each step of a real travel day, from check-in and TSA screening to boarding the plane, with support from airline staff. Participants ranged from preschoolers to young adults, all gaining hands-on experience in a sensory-friendly environment. A short taxi ride on the tarmac helped build confidence and familiarity with flying.

Air travel can be overwhelming for individuals with autism and other intellectual and developmental disabilities, and The Arc's Wings for All® program helps bridge that gap by offering airport rehearsals that empower families and airline staff alike.

This event was made possible through months of thoughtful planning and the dedication of our staff, volunteers, and partners. Together, they are helping create a more inclusive community where every family can travel with confidence.

Staff Spotlight: Sophia Ryals

She also supports all-staff meetings through planning and preparation. On the administrative side, she manages purchasing, organizes therapy billing sheets, updates attendance and student records, and assists with facilities coordination. Her attention to detail and responsiveness help ensure both campuses operate smoothly and efficiently.

Sophia's favorite part of working at PACE is the students. She loves seeing their smiles, watching them build friendships, and witnessing their growth throughout the year. She also finds it especially meaningful to connect with families and hear about the positive impact PACE has made on their lives. Sophia's dedication, organization, and heart for the PACE community contribute to creating a supportive environment where students, families, and staff feel valued and connected.
