The fundraising event will take place in Santana Row Park at Olin Ave & Piazza de Valencia from 1:00pm-4:00pm.

### Mandatory Guidelines

- Your performance **cannot** contain explicit content such as swearing, inappropriate references to drugs and alcohol, racist and/or demeaning language towards any background, culture, race, or sexual orientation. All content must be family-friendly. Violation of this guideline will result in termination from the event.
- Please feel free to wear what you feel comfortable in, but keep in mind that you are representing yourself and PACE. Please refrain from clothing with any explicit language. [We encourage you to wear blue in honor of Autism Awareness Month!](#)

### Performance Instructions

- Please state your name/band name and the song(s) you are performing.
- Each performance would last for 30 minutes, consisting of a 30 minute set with 5 minutes to set-up and 5 minutes to tear-down.
- At the end of the performance, please take a few seconds to remind the audience to make a donation to PACE. **Our goal for Autism Awareness Month is \$20,000!** For example: "Thank you so much for attending the event for PACE. If you haven't done so already and you liked my performance, I encourage you to make a donation to support PACE programs. You can make a huge impact on the lives of individuals with autism! Let's get closer to our goal!"
  - **Tip:** You can also mention your connection to PACE (ex: staff, YLC member, volunteer, etc) or your connection to the autism community.

- 3) Sound equipment will be shared among performers on the main stage.
- 4) The main stage is located next to a children's play area and lawn area that attracts families. All music must be appropriate for all ages and family friendly.
- 5) **Each performance will be approximately thirty (30) minutes, unless performers specify otherwise.**
- 6) You are responsible for the safety of yourself and your belongings.
- 7) The undersigned agrees and does hereby release from liability an to indemnify and hold harmless PACE as regards to Voices for Autism Concert. This release is for any and all liability for personal injuries and property losses or damage occasioned by, or in connection with any activity or accommodations for this event. The undersigned further agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations put forth by PACE and/or affiliate groups and vendors throughout the concert.
